- C** Understand the ways our **CLIMATE** is changing
- A** Take **ACTION** to reduce (mitigate) our carbon emissions

- P** Create a **PLAN** that guides San Antonio's efforts to become climate resilient

- Safe and walkable neighborhoods
- A city powered by solar and wind

**+4°F**  
summer maximum temperatures

**-3**  
inches of average rainfall annually
